Complete and Sign Your Enrollment Form

Enrolling in Catalyst Pathways is voluntary and free. Download the Enrollment Form at

You will fill out this form with your doctor and then your doctor will fax the finished and signed form to Catalyst Pathways.

Connect With a Care Coordinator

You will get a phone call from a Care Coordinator within 24 hours of your enrollment.

The Care Coordinator will:

- Welcome you into Catalyst Pathways and explain next steps
- Introduce your dedicated Patient Access Liaison (PAL)
- Explain insurance coverage and benefits
- Find sources of financial assistance, if needed
- Coordinate shipment of your medication

Explore Financial Assistance

Catalyst Pathways offers different types of financial assistance programs.

You may qualify for:

- Copay assistance (for people with commercial insurance)
- Third-party foundation assistance (from nonprofit organizations)
- Patient Assistance Program (for people without insurance or who are denied coverage)

Meet Your PAL

Once you've spoken with your Care Coordinator, your PAL will contact you to:

- Schedule a meeting (in person or over the phone)
- Answer questions about your medication
- Share updates on the status of your insurance coverage
- Connect you with other community members

A PAL is available to visit with individuals and families face-to-face.

AnovoRx Specialty Pharmacy will call you to confirm your mailing details and preferences and then deliver your medication overnight.

Insurance Navigators

Insurance Navigators work directly with your insurance company to determine coverage and identify whether you need preauthorization for your prescription.
